Ministerial Conference on Global Open Data for Agriculture and Nutrition

The conference focused on “Catalyzing Agricultural Transformation for Inclusive Growth” under the theme “Harnessing the demographic dividend through investment in food and nutrition data.” The Conference was

co-convened by the Government of Kenya, Radeecal Communications and GODAN Secretariat. 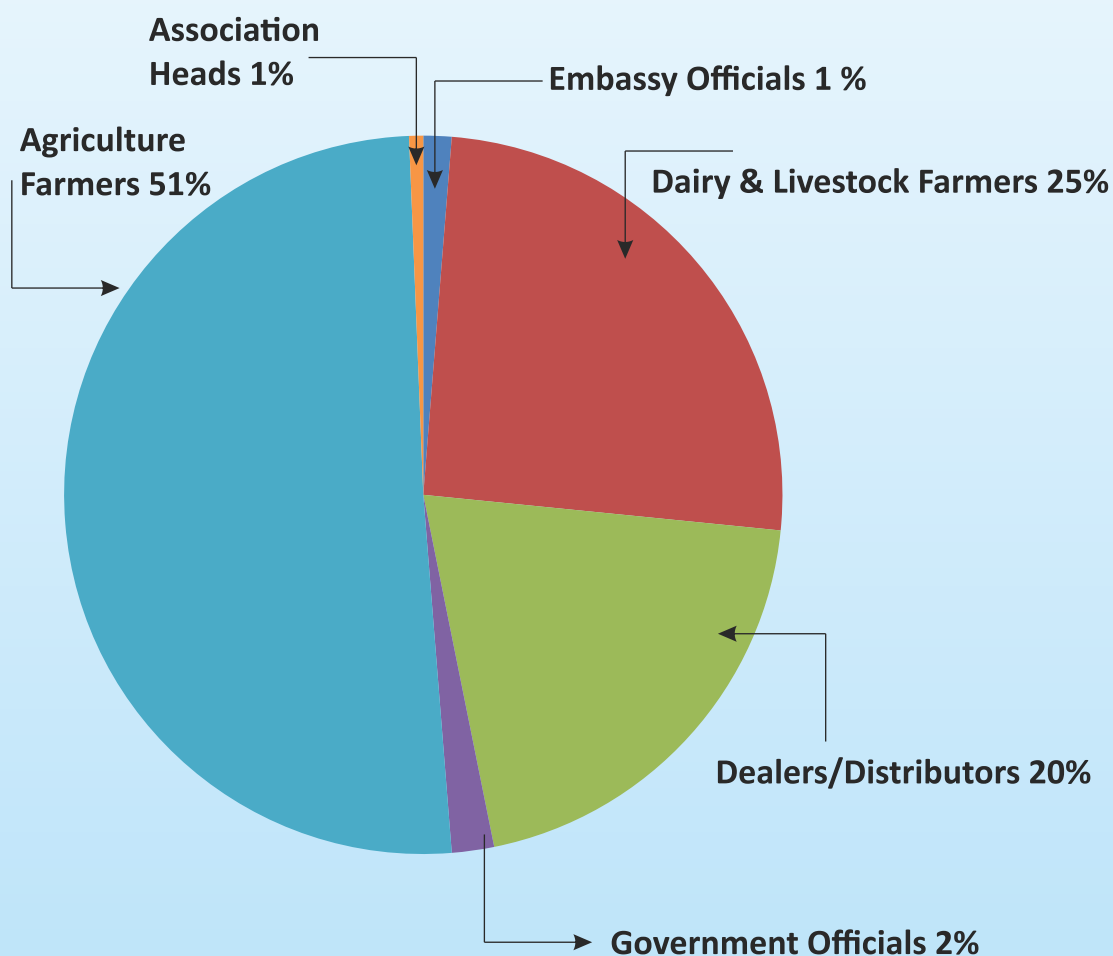

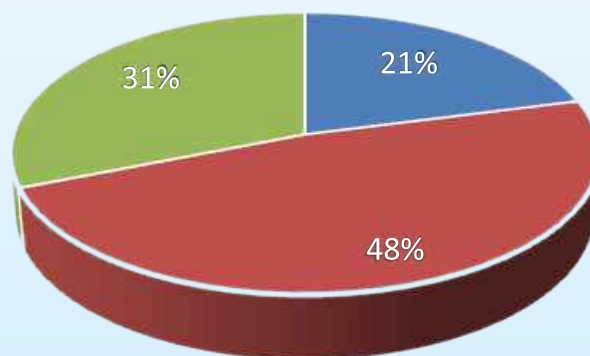

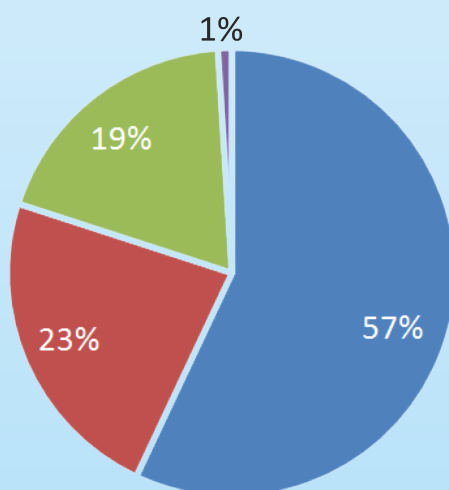

Message from the Cabinet Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock & Fisheries.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries is pleased to host the Ministerial Conference on Agriculture and Nutrition Data and 4th Agritec Africa Exhibition, held in Nairobi at the Kenyatta International Convention Center from June 14-16.

Kenya to conduct Agricultural census aimed at solving food security

For the first time in the history of Kenya, the Ministry of Agriculture with the Kenya National Bureau of Statistics (KNBS) will carry out a nationwide registration of farmers and livestock keepers alongside the country's national census come 2018.

According to the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries Mr Willy Bett, the census is aimed at addressing the plights of farmers across the country.

"The issue of food insecurity can only be addressed by having accurate data and most developed nations are relying on data to predict the weather pattern and that's why we are carrying out this census back to back with the national census in terms of allocating them required resources especially during drought period because of the unknown numbers. With the new techniques in mobile phone communication, we are also planning to use mobile apps to reach farmers," he added.

The census will help the government not only to restructure ways of dealing with the farmers but also address a lot of other issues affecting the farming community.

"Kenya has relied heavily on data from international organizations such as the World Bank, European Union and International Monetary Fund (IMF) yet the information has been sourced from us. We have not been good content developers despite the surrounding endowed environment," Mr Bett added.

"The registration will equally help in weeding out cartels and middlemen that every year swindle farmers," warns Mr Bett. He emphasized on the importance of factual records in the agricultural

sector saying that a new department has been set up within the ministry to help improve data gathering and storage.

challenge to champion the principles of collaboration and use of open data for agriculture and nutrition within the GT and Africa and hosting the Ministerial Conference on Global Open Data for Agriculture and Nutrition for the global south.
