Post Liberalization, the output of Dairy Industry in India is growing at 5% per annum. Currently, we are producing more than 13% of the total milk production of the world, yet the per capita milk availability is comparatively low.

## SCENARIO OF POULTRY INDUSTRY IN INDIA

- › Poultry industry, which started as a backyard activity, has now transformed into a well organized, scientifically oriented and technologically driven industry. Today, our Poultry industry is growing at around 10% per annum.
- › India Livestock Production: Meat 10,252 (Tons) and Gujarat Contribution is 37 TONS
- › India Livestock Production: Egg 143 (Unit mn) And Gujarat Contribution is 1893 (Unit mn)
- › Gujarat ranks around 10th in egg production nationally
- › Gujarat's poultry has grown 15-20% annually, with egg output rising ~5% per year nationally.
- › Production is concentrated in central and southern Gujarat- districts like Kheda, Panchmahals, Vadodara, Surat, Bharuch, Valsad, and Dangs account for over 80% of output





## A RISING POULTRY INDUSTRY

- › The poultry industry in Gujarat is growing rapidly, becoming a key contributor to the state's rural economy and food supply. With increasing demand for protein-rich diets, both layer farming (egg production) and broiler farming (meat production) are expanding steadily. Gujarat is estimated to produce around 1,455 million eggs in 2024–25, meeting local and regional demand.
- › Major poultry clusters are located in Anand, Mehsana, Banaskantha, Bharuch, Mahuva, Wankaner, Palanpur, Mangrol & South Gujarat where farmers are supported by integrators and cooperatives. Broiler chicken farming is thriving due to faster returns and rising urban consumption in cities like Ahmedabad and Surat.
- › Government support through subsidies and technical assistance encourages small and medium-scale farmers to enter the sector. Value-added products like processed chicken and eggs are also gaining market traction. Despite challenges like disease management and feed cost fluctuations, the poultry sector in Gujarat shows strong potential for future growth and even export opportunities.

A Strategic Hub for Animal Husbandry & Agri-Business Growth

Gujarat has emerged as one of India's most progressive and opportunity-rich states for Animal Husbandry, Dairy, Poultry, Fisheries, and allied industries. The sector's rapid growth has not only strengthened milk and protein production but has also significantly boosted the overall farming-economy of the state.

- ◆ Gujarat's livestock population stands strong at around 26.9 million, supporting robust dairy, poultry & allied sectors.
- ◆ Milk production in Gujarat reached over 18.3 million tonnes in 2024, reflecting consistent growth and strong dairy demand.
- ◆ Per-capita milk availability in Gujarat rose to ~730 g/day (2025), significantly above many regions, indicating high local consumption and market potential.
- ◆ Egg production in the state surpassed 2,055 million units in 2025, highlighting the scale of poultry and nutrition markets.
- ◆ Gujarat's fish production is projected to exceed ~10.3 lakh tonnes, making it one of India's fastest-growing fisheries states.
